



## RESIDENTIAL AND OFFICE BUILDING

In a seaside resort town the architects have constructed an L-shaped ensemble of buildings with bright facades and interesting play of detail creating tension between them without introducing dissonance.

The base and entrance gate of the building are clad in Swisspearl Carat black panels, and the two upper floor volumes are set upon it. One volume joins the base in a lighter shade of grey, where as the other stands out as a red clad cube. The grey volume features different themes of façade design, distancing itself from the base, but blurring in with the zinc-clad attic storey.
